The characteristics of a nation's political system letermine the amount of political freedom in that country. Two characteristics that influence the promotion of civil liberties are a lack of religious conflict as an important footor in politics and the political power of the military. France and Nigeria are shaply contrasted ix both of these factors. Religous conflict has always been an important aspect of a nation's pelifical culture. France, like nuch of Europe, is an almost post-religious nation. Although its citizens do have religion, France's politics are not significantly influenced by religious beliefs or conflicts. This means that a particular religion's limitations civil liberties to not limit the scope of religious freedom for France's citizens. This is not the case in Nigeria. Nigeria is a country suffering from Thoug seligous Inisons. About 50 percent of the population to Muslim, 30 percent is Christian, and 20 percent follow traditional religions. As well, the Muslims live mostly in the pooser northern region, while the Christians live mainly in the south. In the past year, sharia, Muslim holy law, has been adopted in the Northern party of Nigeria. In years past Muslims have even total to have Nigeria Jeclaret an Islamic republic like Egypt. Violence has resulted from the religious Livinions within Nigeria. Taken together, this has caused a lower level of political freedom. Sharia law is notable for its disregard of civil liberties, and the wielence caused by this thission toes not grant a high safe of political freedom. France has not been in volved in a major military conflict in decades, and status in the military soes not grant one political power. Again, this is not the case in Nigeria.
